

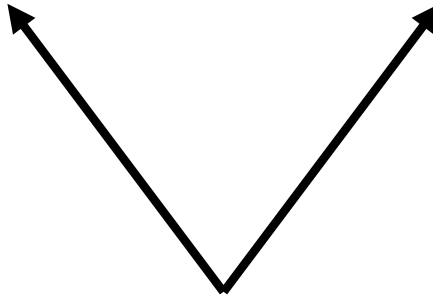
The Solution:

To answer this question you need to use the second conditional.

If + past simple + would

Road 1 LIFE

Road 2 DEATH



You don't know which road is life and which is death but the witchdoctors do. You need to think of a question where they both give the same answer.
(Because you don't know which one you will ask)

Here is the question:

If you were the other witchdoctor which road would you say is life?

The witchdoctor who always tells the truth will tell you Road 2 because that's what the other witchdoctor would do.

The witchdoctor who always lies will also tell you Road 2 because he always lies.

So the answer is: PICK THE OTHER ROAD!!!!
