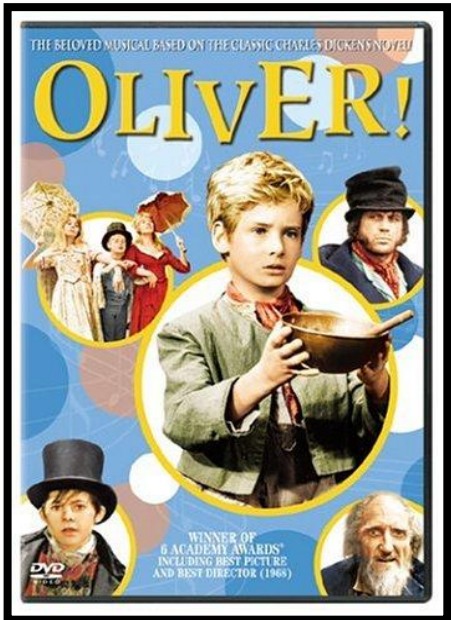


Where Is Love?

Question Formation - Present Tense, Future Tense, Modal Auxiliaries



Oliver! is a musical based on the novel *Oliver Twist* by Charles Dickens. The music and lyrics were written by Lionel Bart. It premiered in the West End in London in 1960. In 1963, it had a long, successful run on Broadway. In 1969, Columbia Pictures made the musical film version.

Oliver Twist is an unloved orphan. He expresses his deep loneliness when he sings *Where Is Love?*

Where Is Love?

Question Formation -Present Tense, Future Tense, Modal Auxiliaries

Present Tense

Use present tense questions to obtain information about the present time.

Questions with *Where* and *BE*

Where + is/are + subject

Where is love?
Where is Oliver?

Yes/No Questions

Do/Does + subject + main verb

Does it fall from skies above?
Does Oliver live with a gang of pickpockets in London?

Yes/No Questions With Be

Is/Are + subject

Is it underneath the willow tree that I've been dreaming of?
Is Oliver an orphan?

Future Tense

Use future tense questions to obtain information about things that have not yet taken place.

Questions with *Will*

Will + subject + adverb + main verb

Will I ever know the sweet "hello" that's meant for only me?
Will someone adopt Oliver?

Where Is Love?

Question Formation -Present Tense, Future Tense, Modal Auxiliaries

Modal Auxiliaries

Use modal auxiliary verbs to talk about ability and necessity.

Questions about possibility with Who and Can

Who + can + main verb

Who	can	say	where she may hide?
Who	can	help	Oliver?

Questions about necessity

Must + subject + main verb

Must	I	travel	far and wide to find you?
Must	Oliver	live	with a gang of pickpockets?
